

Autism Resource Centre Guidelines

The Autism Resource Centre is intended to be a place for Autistic people to access a range of diagnostic and support services.

The Autism Resource Centre is a custom-built space that is truly accessible to Autistic people. The design considers the needs of the autistic community. It is wheel-chair accessible and includes sensory-friendly light sources, quiet rooms, and transition spaces to support people in entering and leaving the building.

To support a safe environment for all people using the Autism Resource Centre please follow these guidelines:

- We offer support via scheduled appointments.
 - We are not a drop-in centre.
- We aim to have someone on reception during core business hours.
 - If no one is on reception, you can wait for your appointment in the transition room, or call 04 803 3501.
- Parents/caregivers please keep your children supervised at all times.
- Sound travels, be mindful of the language you use. Loud swearing and hate speech will not be tolerated.
- Keep doors closed.
- There are 6 designated parks for clients; alternative parking can be found in the local area, especially on Jackson Street and the Esplanade.
